Dues Amnesty

In March 2002, the Board of Trustees approved a recommendation from the Membership Committee to empower the district branches with the authority to decide whether or not to offer dues amnesty to their former members, with the understanding that APA will also offer amnesty of APA dues to former members only within those district branches offering amnesty, and with the further understanding that the reinstating members will pay dues in advance for the year in which they are reinstating.

The following general guidelines apply:

- Amnesty program can begin immediately.
- Reinstating members must have been dropped or resigned from membership one or more years prior to reinstatement.
- Reinstating members must pay for the current dues year in advance (pro-rated based on reinstatement date).
- Not applicable to anyone who has received amnesty in the past.
- No time limit (currently).
