

Assembly Committee of Representatives of Minority/Underrepresented Groups

Composition: The Committee shall consist of the duly elected Representatives and Deputy Representatives of the Minority or Under-represented Groups as identified by the Assembly. These Representatives elect their own chair. The chair of this Committee or a designee is an ex-officio member of the Assembly Executive Committee.

The identified minority groups to have representation in the Assembly are:

- American Indian, Alaska Native, and Native Hawaiian
- Asian-American
- Black
- Hispanic
- Lesbian, Gay and Bisexual
- Women
- International Medical Graduate psychiatrists

Voting and Responsibilities: The Representatives will each have one vote in the Assembly and will have all of the privileges of any other Representative of the Assembly. The Deputy Representative will have all the privileges of any District Branch Deputy Representative of the Assembly. It will be the responsibility of the Representative to provide a report to the minority group after each Assembly meeting regarding all issues considered and the Representative's vote on those issues that come to vote.

The regular reports of the Minority/Underrepresented Groups to the Assembly should reflect on an ongoing basis the problems and progress in solving the problems that affect Minority/underrepresented psychiatrists and the patient populations that they reflect.
